Title: Cleaning & Operation of Vacuum Cleaner

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1.0 OBJECTIVE:

To lay down a procedure for cleaning & operation of Vacuum Cleaner.

2.0 SCOPE:

This procedure is applicable to cleaning & operation of Vacuum Cleaner.

3.0 RESPONSIBILITY:

Stores -Officer, Stores Executive. Head Stores

4.0 **PROCEDURE:**

4.1 Cleaning of Vacuum Cleaner:

Frequency - Once in shift.

- 4.1.1 Ensure that power supply is "Off".
- 4.1.2 Detach the plug from the socket.
- 4.1.3 Affix "TO BE CLEANED LABEL" Wrap the vacuum cleaner with cleaned polythene bag then transfer the vacuum cleaner to washing area.
- 4.1.4 Dismantle the hosepipe and nozzle from the container of vacuum cleaner.
- 4.1.5 Unclamp the top lid (with motor assembly) from the container.
- 4.1.6 Collect the dust from the container in polythene bag, disperse it into water and destroy it into the ETP.
- 4.1.7 Clean the container from inside and outside with 1% v/v Teepol solution and rinse with purified water. Dry the container using a clean dry cloth.
- 4.1.8 Remove the filter bag, put it in a double poly bag and close it. Transfer the bag to filter cleaning area for cleaning.
- 4.1.9 Clean the hosepipe and nozzle by running purified water until it is seen visually clean from outside and inside.
- 4.1.10 After cleaning, keep the pipe and nozzle in an inverted position so as to drain the excess water.
- 4.1.11 Wipe the vacuum cleaner top lid & wire by using wet mop and then dry with a dry clean cloth.
- 4.1.12 Assemble the filter bag to the container with the help of clamps provided for this purpose.



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- 4.1.13 Fix the hose pipe and nozzle to the container of the vacuum cleaner.
- 4.1.14 Wrap the vacuum cleaner with cleaned polythene bag after cleaning and affix the status label as "CLEANED"
- 4.1.15 Record the activity in "Vacuum cleaner cleaning record" as per Annexure-I.

4.2 **Operation of Vacuum Cleaner:**

- 4.2.1 Bring the vacuum cleaner to the site of work, where cleaning is necessary.
- 4.2.2 Remove the polythene bag and fix the plug to the socket of main electric supply available near by area.
- 4.2.3 Switch "ON" the mains from electrical panel.
- 4.2.4 Start the vacuum cleaner.
- 4.2.5 Place the open mouth of the nozzle at the point from where dust is to be cleaned.
- 4.2.6 Check visually the cleanliness of the area.
- 4.2.7 After the dust is removed, stop the vacuum cleaner.
- 4.2.8 Switch "OFF" the mains and disconnect the plug from the socket.
