### **1.0 OBJECTIVE:**

To lay down a procedure for Operation & Cleaning of Battery Operated stacker in stores Area.

### **2.0 SCOPE:**

This SOP is applicable for Cleaning, Operation & charging of Battery Operated stacker in stores Area.

### **3.0 RESPONSIBILITY:**

Operator, Officer, Executive - Stores, Head Stores.

### 4.0 **PROCEDURE:**

### 4.1 Cleaning of Stacker in Stores Area:

- 4.1.1 By using a clean, dry lint free duster wipe out all the surface of stacker.
- 4.1.2 Roll the stacker wheel on wet duster, so that wheel gets cleaned.

### 4.2 Before putting stacker in operation first check:

- 4.2.1 Check the break, horn and safety button is in working condition.
- 4.2.2 Check that there is enough hydraulic oil in system by lifting the carriage to its top position, if not inform to engineering department immediately.
- 4.2.3 Check that the batteries are fully charged and that the acid level is correct in each cell.

### 4.3 **Operation of the stacker:**

Note: Only authorized persons can operate the stacker.

- 4.3.1 Always wear a safety shoes and helmet before the operation of stacker.
- 4.3.2 Pull out the red emergency power cut-off switch to ON.
- 4.3.3 Insert the keys in lock and turn the key switch ON.
- 4.3.4 Pull down the tiller arm to driving position until to hear click sound, which indicates that the main contractor has been connected.
- 4.3.5 Turn the toggle switch clockwise for forward driving and anticlockwise for reverse driving.
- 4.3.6 When the toggle switch moved from neutral position, you will hear a click, which indicates the electro-magnetic parking brake being released.



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- 4.3.7 Push the Up arrow push button to lift the load fork and push the down arrow push button to lower the load fork.
- 4.3.8 Use the Horn button when viewing angle is not clear and whenever necessary.
- 4.3.9 The tiller arm having safety reverse buttons which secure the operator against being squeezed between the tiller arm and a wall, a rack, or any other obstacles.
- 4.3.10 In Battery indicator the green light in the field indicates remaining energy level in the battery, Double red flash in the field indicates 75% battery discharge and single red flash signals 80% battery discharge.

**Note:** In battery indicator single red flash signals observed do not operate the stacker. Immediately connect with charger for charging.

- 4.3.11 Always use folding platform to operate the stacker.
- 4.3.12 Press the red emergency power cut-off switch down to stop the working of stacker.

### 4.4 Caution! :

- 4.4.1 Don't drive the stacker on wet and oily surface.
- 4.4.2 Don't drive the Unloaded stacker by lifting the fork up.
- 4.4.3 Watch for the Swing clearance when turning near walls, racks, pillars or other obstacles.
- 4.4.4 Don't exceed the rated capacity of the vehicles as marked on the nameplate as per supplier/manufacturer.

### 4.5 Charging of Stacker batteries:

- 4.5.1 Connect the charger only to the stacker's battery charging connector.
- 4.5.2 Connect the charger plug to the AC mains socket and switch on the AC power.
- 4.5.3 In the charger, switch on the power using the "POWER ON" switch.
- 4.5.4 Ensure that the LED's against "AC ON", "DC ON" and "CHARGING STATUS" are growing.
- 4.5.5 When charging begins, the charging current will display in the amps LED's.
- 4.5.6 When the battery is 100% charged the charging Red LED glows and the charging automatically stops.
- 4.5.7 Disconnect the stacker battery from the charger, before disconnecting, switch OFF the power switch.
