### 1.0 **OBJECTIVE:**

To lay down a procedure for Cleaning and Sanitization/Sterilization of tools/Spanners used in aseptic area.

### 2.0 SCOPE:

This SOP is applicable for cleaning & sanitization/sterilization of various type of tools use in aseptic area for adjustment, change over and repairing of equipments/machineries in Production Department.

### **6.0 PROCEDURE:**

# 6.1 CLEANING AND SANITIZATION OF TOOLS / SPANNERS:

- **6.1.1** The tools are primarily clean with WFI to minimized oil or Grease which is accumulated during daily work or maintenance
- **6.1.2** Then scrub with 1% solution .of SLS to get free from oil or grease
- **6.1.3** Finally rinse with WFI and dry with the help of compressed air and check visually , it should be free from any stain
- 6.1.4 After cleaning, cleaned tools / spanners shall be sanitization with filtered 70% IPA solution to avoid possible contamination and finally dry at room temperature
- **6.1.5** Tools shall be cleaned after every operation or whenever used for rectification of machine or equipments

# **6.2 PROCEDURE FOR USING:**

**6.2.1** Cleaning and sanitized tools shall be taken in aseptic area for daily use or maintenance work via dynamic pass box under UV exposure for 20 minutes

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**6.2.2** Tools dedicated for use in aseptic area shall be used in aseptic area to avoid cross contamination. Rusted and damaged tools shall not be used in aseptic area

# **6.3 PRECAUTIONS:**

- The tools which are in aseptic area should be stainless steel .
- Ensure complete dryness of tools after sanitization or sterilization .
- All tools/spanners should be kept in cleaned and sanitized stainless steel tool box and when not in used . closed
- Frequently check for rust and damaged , if found , avoid for further use.
- Tools which are made up of stainless steel shall be sterilized weekly.
